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## Acknowledgment

We gratefully and humbly acknowledge and admire the trust shown on us by JRDTJTT, SDTT. This has given us even more responsibility and courage to perform the remaining task with greater dedication. We had been able to enrich our human resource and could perform lots of resource mobilization activities for the humble community of domestic workers and their families.

## Summary

Domestic workers mobilization programme at Saathi Centre, ISST Kalyanpuri completed its third phase in September 2012. During the third phase we included two additional areas to identify more domestic workers for mobilization programme. Our community mobilizers contacted and surveyed 300 domestic workers from Trilokpuri Block No. 2 and Khichripur Block 7-8. As we learned tremendously from the previous phases, we could gain knowledge and wisdom to initiate certain new activities to facilitate, encourage and enthuse to domestic workers create and ensure better life condition for themselves and their families.

We encountered a considerable number of domestic workers who had to leave their work and many of them took long gaps from work due to some kind of illness. These illnesses range from anemia, lower levels of hemoglobin, lung infection to tuberculosis and hypertension. It is very important to find out the factors as to why these women are compelled to leave their work temporarily or permanently. The result of a small survey done by ISST mobilizers shows the following results.

After the completion of third phase we did an informal evaluation through focused group discussions. We found 108 domestic workers reported improvement in their health status. Most of them were previously suffering from iron/calcium deficiency, general weakness (anemia), acute anemia, high sugar level, hypertension and some of them were found suffering from more serious diseases like leukoderma, STD etc. To fulfill the need and demand we not only coordinated with GRC's of the respective areas but also organized exclusive health camps and clinics to fill the gaps. Eventually we established a small centre which was named Sakhi Kendra by these women. This centre is working as health guide for all domestic workers who are associated with us and also for those who cannot regularly connect with us but need some kind of support or intervention.

Number of Self Help groups of domestic workers has been increased to 10 groups now. The accounts of these groups have been opened in nationalized banks. The members of the groups have also been trained in Para- medical skills so that they can volunteer in their Sakhi Kendra to provide services and guidance to their counterparts.

Bachpan centre has been expanded with 65 more children added at Saathi Bachpan Programme. 50% of these children belong to the domestic workers families. Within a span of one and a half year we have been able to reach out to more than 250 children and an equal number of youth and adolescents. This connection has been established through different activities like life skills training, RTI workshops, theatre activities, discussion group meetings and vocational training workshops. Saathi Centre has been successfully providing them a secure, conducive and disciplined environment to learn, interact and enhance their capacities.

The staff of saathi centre is receiving various trainings throughout the year. The trainings are conducted and planned after observing the gaps and grey areas while performing daily tasks and activities. These trainings include time utilization, checking your own behavior and conduct, community mobilization on health issues etc

- 1. Mobilizing women domestic worker to enhance their quality of life through various interventions.**
- 2. Setting up child care and youth resource centre and link the children of D.W. to these programmes and support them through crucial years of their development.**
- 3. To provide appropriate and adequate training to the staff to ensure effective intervention on daily basis and also to enrich ISST'S resource bank.**
- 4. Empowering domestic workers through formal SHG's and pressure groups to take charge of their own life.**

### **SUB OBJECTIVES:-**

- 1. Mainstreaming of domestic workers & their families.**
- 2. Providing information regarding government facilities.**
- 3. Legal awareness and assistance.**
- 4. Awareness regarding health nutrition and cleanliness.**
- 5. Listening to their problems/grievances and exploring solutions.**
- 6. Formation of pressure groups and self help groups.**
- 7. Running a Right to Information help desk.**
- 8. Establishing linkages thorough networking with ISST, GRC and other government and non-government initiatives.**
- 9. Skill development of domestic workers and their young daughters in the same area or other areas of their interest.**
- 10. Encouragement and enrollment of their dropout daughters and sons in open schooling system.**



## SUMMARY OF THE MEETINGS HELD WITH DOMESTIC WORKERS



### 1.

#### Information/issues:-

- Health check up camp was organized as demanded by the domestic workers.
- A lady doctor was engaged to conduct the check up.
- Blood pressure and weight measurements were also recorded.
- Most of them were suffering from weakness, backache, body pain and common cold and cough.
- Medicines were also distributed during the camp.

## 2.

Date & Month :- 31-July-2012  
Venue :- T camp, 5-6 Block, Khichripur  
Time :- 2:30pm To 5:00pm

### Information/issues:-

- The topic of the meeting was water sanitation and conservation.
- According to WHO report 80% diseases originate by unclean water.
- Water should be taken from neat and clean places.
- We should utensils with handle to take out the water from the pots.
- All utensils should be covered properly.
- Chlorination of water is very useful. Chlorine tablets are available free of cost from government health clinics.

## 3.

### Information/issues:-

- This time we planned to have two competitions to provide some different experience to women.
- Half of the women were asked to prepare some nutritious dishes and half of them participated in a quiz competition.
- Women thoroughly enjoyed the programme.
- Judges selected the winners and attractive gifts were also given to them.

## 4.

Date & Month :- 22/23 August, 2012

Subject :- Para Medical training workshop

Need for the training- It was observed and felt during the past experiences that there is tremendous need among the women to understand their own body and to become capable to deal with small medical demands like checking the body temperature, blood pressure, dressing the wound etc. They have no other choice but to go to the local doctors.

On day one they were introduced to some normal medicines like PCM (paracetamol) citrazine, amoxy and common cold and cough medicines and different antacids. Even if the local doctor or quack prescribes these medicines they should know what they are for and what is the price of these in the market.

On day two they were trained on how to take care of patient at home, how to change the bed sheet of the patient and normally what type of food should be given to the patients. We should not give spices to the patients and be careful about the cleanliness around the patient, the room should be airy and always wash hands before and after touching the patient, Thermometer should be cleaned with dettol water after using it.

The session was made interactive with question rounds.

A pharmacist and a trained nurse were engaged as resource persons.

## 5.

### Paramedical Training (follow-up and practice)

The training was started with a question answer round by resource person to review the previous meeting's learning and to know as to what these women recollect. To the surprise of the resource person, women not only answered all the questions but also put some other queries related to medical complications like throat pain, different types of abdominal pains and related first aid to be given to patients. They enquired about different doses to be given to different age groups of children and also to adults.

Resource person told them about the reasons and prevention of different diseases in details.

In the end women practiced to measure body temperature with the help of thermometer and blood pressure by BP apparatus in the presence of the resource person.

- Even widows and divorced ladies can suffer these types of violence by relatives, parents, neighbourhood and surroundings.

Information / Issues.

- Creating a concept of helping each other in a group is the best way to resolve problems of day to day life.
- In a Self Help Group women can help each other and the whole community in a number of ways.
- Financial security is one of the major safeguards against odds, which can be ensured through forming a self help group.
- S H G's have been approved and recognized by our government and can get attached to any nationalized bank.
- Poor women generally save some money for emergency and keep it somewhere secretly in the small house or hut but there are high chances that this money may get lost, stolen or spent in unnecessary items.
- If they form a group of 15- 20 women and keep the collected money in the bank, they can have large amoune after some months or a few years and use the money during emergency or in need.
- They can also avail facility of loan in a very small interest.

## Jute- Bead Training Workshop.

(Started in November 2012, will continue till the end of January 2013.)

During our community meetings, domestic workers and their daughters expressed very keen interest and desire to learn some additional skills with which they can do some kind of work at home. After thorough discussion with them a three months jute- bead training workshop has been started from November 2012. In this training they are learning to make.

- Jute bags.
- Jute and bead wall hangings.
- Other jute items like newspaper/magazine holders.



- Bracelets/bands.
- Earrings.

## BACHPAN PROGRAMME



A very vibrant and innovative programme for children from different age groups is extremely crucial especially for the families of domestic workers. In most of the cases woman is away from the house since morning till afternoon and in the evening for two to three hours. Children are either left unattended or with neighbors.

In Saathi centre we provide them very positive environment laced with love, care, dignity and most importantly knowledge with reason. Every child has been provided with an I' card with his/her photograph pasted on it. They have been divided into five houses and every house contains children from different age groups. The names for the houses were given by children themselves in a group discussion meeting. Following names have been selected.

1. Eklavya
2. Abhimanyu
3. Bhakt Prahlad

4. Dhruv
5. Chhota Bheem

On daily basis we have two batches in both the centers. There is one morning batch and one afternoon batch. All the batches have three groups of children that are pre- school, remedial and school dropouts.

## **BALMANCH ACTIVITIES**

Children conduct Balmanch last week of every month. They select the theme and prepare the whole activities by themselves with the help of their teachers. These activities are carefully designed to inculcate good habits and to unlearn some of the negative traits that have been developed because of the negative surroundings. Reports of the monthwise Balmanch activities are as follows.

### ***1. Essay Competition (31.7.2012)***

“Rakhee kaa tyohaar” was the topic of essay competition. Before the competition teachers divided the children in groups and discussed about this festival. They were asked to write how they would like to celebrate this festival. The purpose of this whole activity was to inculcate the real spirit of festivals in children and not just to have fun.

### ***2. Independence Day (14.8.2012)***

Both the centers celebrated Independence Day at Saathi center on 14<sup>th</sup> of August, 2012.

Programme started with Saraswati Vandana. Children prepared a very beautiful dance drama “Sabrang” depicting all the festivals of India. Apart from this group songs like “Mile sur mera Tumhaara” were also presented.

In the end feature film “Ferrari ki sawaari” was shown. The film show was a reward to the children for their discipline and mannerism shown during the whole celebration.

### ***3. Importance of festivals (29.9.2012)***

Five houses of children prepared plays on five festivals of five different religions. Plays on Deepawali, Eid, Guruparab, Christmas and Onam were prepared and presented in a very light and humorous way. As plays were prepared in a very short period, the children were confused and mixing one with another. In the end it was concluded in a group discussion that every festival should be celebrated together with the spirit of oneness.

### ***4. General Awareness Competition (31.10.2012)***

Children were divided into three groups according to their age. Worksheets were prepared with objective type questions. Most of the questions were related to our environment, self awareness, health and hygiene and our

family. Very small children were asked oral questions like names and colours of fruits and vegetables. Children also sang songs related to environment and good habits. Prizes and refreshments were distributed in the end.

### ***5. Tree Plantation (31.11.2012)***

Children were told about the need to plant more trees because environmental pollution is increasingly threatening the survival of living beings day by day. Plants were arranged by the local municipal councilor Mr. Rajkumar Dhillon, who warmly appreciated children's enthusiasm to plant trees. A Gardner was called as a resource person, who taught the children how to plant trees. He also told them that it is extremely important to take utmost day to day care of the plants if we wish them to grow as beautiful trees.

### ***6. Welcome New Year (31.12.2012)***

Centre took New Year pledge to not to create environmental pollution by discarding plastic bags. Every child made personal determination to leave at least one bad habit in the coming year. Children of ISST theatre group NAKSHATRA presented a play Aao Haath Milaayen on the plight of the girl child.

### ***Monthly Assessment of Children:-***

Monthly assessment is the activity done every month to know the pace of progress made by each student so that weak children could be given extra attention. The assessments are done not only to see their educational growth but also to examine the improvement in their behavior, personality and health. Each assessment is done very carefully by trained Bachpan staff to identify the children with special need.

After these continuous assessments it was noticed that we have more children having Dyslexia and ADHD than any other problems like autism or mental retardation. Keeping this in mind we have decided to have two exclusive training workshops for our staff on these two problems in the coming months.

### ***Parents-Teacher Meetings:-***

Once in every month our teachers organize meeting with the parents. The meetings focus on.

- To appraise the parents regarding the progress made by their children in studies.
- To generate awareness regarding good behavior and mannerisms they must display at home to inculcate the same in their children in turn.
- To give them suggestions about the food and nutrition necessary for a child of growing age.
- To motivate them to become more responsible for the mental, physical and emotional growth of their children.

## ***Bal-Utsav 10-November-2012 :-***

### **Introduction & Planning:-**

ISST, Saathi centre celebrates its annual day as “Bal Utsav” every year. Bal Utsav is a full day celebration for the students of Saathi Centre, for which children wait whole the year. ISST, Saathi centre decided to celebrate “Bal Utsav” on 10th Nov.-2012 from 10:00 am to 4:00pm this year. The preparation for “Bal Utsav” started 15 days before, various duties and responsibilities were distributed among staff and volunteers to make this program successful. Invitation cards were prepared, and distributed to all the guests one week prior. Saathi centre planned food stalls for “Bal Utsav” first time.

### **Materials used:-**

**Drawing sheets, sketch pens, wax colors, pencils, poster colors, brush, prizes, gifts, different items and tents for food stalls etc.**

**Strength of participants:- 250 children (approx)**

## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE DAY**

ISST, Saathi centre celebrates its annual day as “Bal Utsav” every year. ISST, Saathi centre organized “Bal Utsav” on 10th Nov.-2012 from 10:00 am to 4:00pm.

In the beginning of “Bal Utsav” we welcomed all the children and guests with “Tilak” on their forehead and served “Saunf-Mishri” as sweet. One volunteer from Bachpan carried out this responsibility very humbly.

After the welcome Saathi centre organized many competitions among Bachpan children like:-G.K competition (for age group 5-7, 8-10 and 11-13 yrs.), select same shapes from different shapes in stipulated time (for age group 3-4 yrs) and poster competition for all the children of bachpan. Besides this, a poster and debate competition were organized for youth. We gave some topics for the poster competition like:-save water, save girl, save wild life, save earth/environment etc. and for debate competition the topic was “Adhunik sayantron ka jeewan per prabhav”( आधुनिक सयंत्रों का जीवन पर प्रभाव ).

For the competition, all material like:-drawing sheets, pencils, erasers, colors, sketch pens, brush, were made available by Saathi centre.

For the first time we set-up three food stalls which were Chana-Chaat, Bhel-Poori, Nimboo Paani on reasonable cost (every item for Rs.2/-), which were handled by the youth volunteers. The experience of putting stalls was wonderful.

After the competitions children enjoyed food from food stalls.



One and half hour magic and puppet show was shown in the afternoon, all students enjoyed both shows. Then everybody danced on the floor. It was amazing experience during the dance as there was no difference between students and teachers, all enjoyed it.



**Then refreshment was distributed among the children.**

After the refreshment and celebration 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions were rewarded by prizes. There was gifts for volunteers and consolation prizes for all children and certificates of carpentry workshop were also distributed by the guest.

In the end a big thanks was given by the coordinator of Saathi Centre to all the guests, staff members, volunteers and to the children for their contribution and support to make this program successful.

## TEN DAYS FILM BONANZA AT SAATHI CENTRE

Mr. Negi from CFSI also address children and encouraged them to not only enjoy the films but also learn lesson from each film to grow as a finer adult and responsible citizen.

The haal of the screening of films was duly decorated with colorful kites and flowers. The banner of the forth coming film “**GATTU**” displayed in the premises. The projector and screen were arranged by NGO.

**Proceeding Days:-** Different films were screened every day. Children enjoyed each day. Children enjoyed each film only with lots of enthusiasm. They were also served with nutritious snakes like Chana Chat, Fruits, and biscuits every day.

# YOUTH RESOURCE CENTER



## ***Integrated Learning:-***

After a long time experience Saathi center educators and trainers realized that children of marginalized communities need an integrated learning experience to cope and to realize their actual potential. It was discussed at length with them in groups as to how should we structure and design our training programme. Most of the youngsters were in favor of a wholesome learning experience where they can learn basic computer skills, spoken English, personality development skills, interview skills and life skills. Thus taking clues from them we designed a package with an effort to include all the important aspects that can prepare them to enter the workforce.

## ***Life Skills Workshop***

Date	:-	22 <sup>nd</sup> and 23 <sup>rd</sup> May, 2012
Venue	:-	Basti Vikas Kendra, 32, Block Trilokpuri.
Number of Participants	:-	40

Day one session started with an introduction round. The activity named “Mera Aaina Meri Tasveer” was used as an icebreaking activity. The aim of the activity was to understand oneself better and in true colour.

The activity “Mai Kaun Tum Kaun” was performed to get familiar with each other. “Tere Mere Sapne” was yet another activity to make them aware and mindful about their own dreams and aspirations.

A fun game “Kana Phusi” was played to evaluate the concentration level while listening and giving away message to others.

Next days’ session was based on to inculcate listening skills and also to understand the difference between reacting and responding. A game “Follow me” was played to make the participants understand different emotions like anger, fear, disgust, joy etc.

The activity “Mera Nazaria” was to understand the importance of positive attitude while the story “Sabka Sukh Param Sukh” was discussed to sensitize the group towards others’ pains and problems.

### ***Right to Information Camps:-***

**Planning and Publicity** ----- Camps were planned and publicized after having focused group discussions with communities by our community mobilizers. During the meetings people especially women showed their anger regarding the non-availability of rations in the ration shops and also paying bribes to get different certificates from government departments. They also showed displeasure about inefficient garbage collection and street cleaning systems.

These camps were attended by more than 50 people each. Many people were benefited by these camps. RTI applications for birth certificates, ration cards, caste certificates, voter cards and school admissions were written during the camps. Some of the people also filed applications for sanitation and poor condition of roads.

### ***RTI Pressure Groups:-***

Two more pressure groups have been formed during the last six months apart from one group which was formed earlier. The members of one of the pressure groups are young girls and boys of the community while other group belongs to the women of the community.

These groups have meetings at regular intervals and also file RTI applications for various common causes like condition of the roads, community toilets and garbage collection system etc.

### ***Main streaming through open school registrations:-***

A considerable number of adolescents and youth in marginalized communities are pushed or pulled out of schools due to harsh circumstances at home. These children require little bit of motivation and support to continue their education. Saathi centre's peer support group helps and motivates these children through open school registration. We have not only included all the books and guides of open school class 10th and 12th in our library but also provide them coaching and guidance wherever they require.

### ***Computer course assessment***

**The most encouraging part of the current session is that during this session we were able to collaborate with "Jan Shikshan Sansthan" of the ministry of HRD for assessment and certification. The examination of the first batch after this collaboration was held on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2012.**

The next batch is scheduled to start from January 7, 2013



### ***Exposure Trip (Adolescents) 28-12-2012***

After the examination the children were taken for an exposure trip to Nehru Planetarium and National Science Centre. In both the places children learned a lot apart from entertainment. In Nehru Planetarium they saw a beautiful show of night sky, stars and their movements, planets, their names and position and relevance etc. In National Science Centre they learned and practically did a lot to know about motion, light, sound, weight and number of other scientific phenomena.



### ***Vocational Training:- CARPENTRY***

During our community meetings we came to understand that there are quite a number of adolescents and Youth who had to dropout after class 5<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> due to poverty and frequent migrations of parents, There youth needed to learn a Vocational trade according to their educational background. It was thought appropriate to organize one month carpentry training for youth with low educational qualifications. The carpentry workshop was organized in the month of October 2012. The children learned the following:-

- **Material required by a Carpenter.**
- **Selection of wood, board, mica etc.**
- **How to cut the board symmetrically.**



- How to measure length & width to make an item like bence.
- How to joint corners.
- How to insert nails.
- Preparing an-almirah, bench, table rack etc.

The participants learned everything with great interest and expressed the desire to learn more about carpentry.

### **1. Meaning of Friendship:-**

A Constructive and fruitful Session was held on "Meaning of Friendship" The meeting started with a role play performed by the students. Their observation and comments stated the discussion. The meanings of true friendship, opposite Sex Friendship, behavior in a classroom etc. were the issues up.

The discussion among students was very healthy and meaningful. They were encouraged to express their feelings openly and clearly. Students felt very comfortable in airing their views and wanted to have discussions on the topics like these more oftenly.

### **2. Imagination:-**

We are living in totally objective world and whenever we get spare time, we only watch television. Children in our modern Society have lost power of imagination. Imagination is very powerful tool to develop innovation and creativity.

A beautiful skit was presented before the group on how we can enjoy and enrich our selves through imagining positive things in life.

All the students were given activities in groups to perform certain tasks using their imagination.

### **3. Superstition:-**

Students had themselves selected this topic because they got confused due to number of things, and behaviors shown by their parents and elders that have no logical ground like they are often told by the parents that should not move or go forward of a cat crossed their way, they should also not leave for important work if somebody



sneezes while they are going out. Children listed hundreds of superstitions and myths they have been told to follow. The discussion ended with the realization that the superstitions have no scientific base and it is our ignorance of the scientific facts that we keep of following certain unnecessary traditions and rituals.

#### **4. Team Work**

The topic of the meeting was team work. Meeting started with task given to the participants. Everyone was asked to work in groups to do the task of completing jigsaw puzzles. The rationale behind the activity was discussed. The concept of team work, benefits and drawback of team work were shared. Students shared their experience of working in a team. They even agreed that if our leaders (in politics are working for the welfare of people) worked with cooperation and as a team it benefits the citizens and the Country as a whole. The discussion turned out to be very enriching for the students and they vowed to develop this capacity in them.

#### **5. Citizen's Rights and Responsibilities**

The topic for the discussion (was selected by the students) was Citizen's Rights and Responsibilities. The meeting started with all the students discussing about the legal/constitutional Provisions provided for the citizens. The discussion rolled towards what the provisions were and what the ground realities were. There was heated debate on completion, inability of the government system to deliver, insensitive leaders etc. However, on the issues of citizen's responsibilities it took sometime for everyone to come up with response. Students were encouraged to speak on their responsibility towards their community and state. Few felt that they as citizens should take care of the public property like-buses, tubelights on the street etc., few advocated that garbage and waste should not be littered around, We all have to work towards keeping our environment clean. Suggestions like, we should vote regularly, respect our senior citizens etc were also given by the students

The meeting ended on a very happy and positive note as everyone felt that they knew how they could contribute to their country.

#### **6. Crime against Women**

The recent gang rape case of Nirbhaya in Delhi has shaken the young girls and boys so much that they wanted to discuss it seriously. All agreed that the whole system is responsible for these types of incidents. The blame game will not bring any change until all of us police, judiciary, politicians and public take some responsibility and do not just shed our responsibility by gossiping and criticizing others. Police is not doing its duty, judiciary is taking a long process, politicians are only encashing by taking political mileage but do we, as public are doing our duty honestly, certainly not. Everybody agreed on this point. In the end all of the youth girls and boys took a pledge to become a responsible citizen and courageously take action wherever and whenever it is required.

## ***Summary of the meeting***

- Communication and dialogue are important aspects of interpersonal relationship.
- It is vital to understand the difference between reacting and responding to a person or situation.
- Patience and humility are the key factors in maintaining healthy communication.
- Participants were asked to identify and write about one of the major area of their life where change is required.
- The problem areas were discussed in detail. Self motivation was encouraged through introspection and meditation techniques.

## **PARALEGAL TRAINING FOR STAFF & VOLUNTEERS**

Date :- 16 & 18 Aug-2012

Time :- 11:00 to 4:00 pm

Trainer – Sana Siddiqui

A two day legal training was conducted on 16 and 18 August, at kalyanpuri East Delhi. The aim of the training was to equip the participants with important legal information which is relevant keeping in view of their work profile. The participants were mostly the staff members of ISST and few member from the community, students and house-wives.

The two day training was split in to two parts

- **Basic understanding of law**
- **Focus on rights**
  - o **Vis-a-vis police**
  - o **Marriage and divorce**
  - o **Domestic violence**
  - o **Juveniles**
  - o **Dowry**

In part one of the training the participants were explained the basic structure of law and how the government functions. The constitution and its relations with other legislations, fundamental Rights and other Common rights. The structure of the government legislature, judiciary and executive was discussed and their role in the entire system of government.

On second part of the legal training more focused and subsatantive rights were discussed. In rights related to police following issues were taken up explained and discussed

- **Filing of FIR**
- **Arrest and detention**
- **Bailable and non-bailable offence**
- **Cognizable and non cognizable offence**
- **Right to bail**
- **Trial**
- **Role of prosecutor**

The issues were taken one by one and along-side queries of participants were also addressed. The rights of a victim as well as of accused were discussed.

The procedure and rights as given under Juvenile Justice Act were also discussed. Rights of bail, the orders that can be passed against a juvenile, and what all documents /evidence can be produced to show the age of the Juvenile.

The rights in a matrimonial relationship were also discussed in detail.

Participants were given few case studies to discuss and find out the possible solutions. The cases were related to inter-religious marriage, age of marriage, domestic violence, cruelty, Hindu marriage, Muslim Marriage and marriage under Special Marriage Act. Grounds of divorce, relief or protection orders as provided under Protection of Women of from Domestic Violence Act 2005. Dowry Prohibition Act, 498-A, dowry Death, Hindu Marriage Act etc.

A film “aise hoti hai shaadi” was also screened and discussed.

It can be concluded that the two day training was successful as participants interest in understanding the legal aspect of an issue was enhanced as well as the curiosity to know more was also awakened.

### ***Meetings with GRC's***

As we are working in close collaboration with local Gender Resource Centres, we organize meetings with their staff members. The meetings focussed on strengthening the networking and support mechanism with them and also to enhance their skills along with the staff of Saathi Centre.

### ***Community Mobilization through Songs (23.10.12)***

The representatives from three GRC's were present in this meeting. These were Asha Deep Foundation from Kalyanpuri, Krishna Foundation from Mandawli and Chetnalaya from Trilokpuri. We called a resource person Vidya Thapa from Action India to facilitate the group. Resource person not only elaborated the value of singing songs among the women, she also told them about different types of songs for different occasions. She said that if you want to change the attitude and hearts of the people then songs and plays are the most effective medium. Songs directly reach the hearts without hurting the sentiments of the people. She taught the group various songs to sensitize and motivate communities regarding girl child, dowry system, educating the girl, gender equality , violence against women etc.

### ***Value of Time (24.12.12)***

This meeting was also attended by staff of three GRC's. First of all an exercise was given to them to identify their own time wasters. Every participant made a chart of his/her own routine work in the office and identified the gaps where he/she tends to waste time on gossiping, talking over mobile or just talking with colleague etc. After the exercise, a calculation was done and it was found that everyone wastes atleast one to one and a half hour everyday and this comes to around 20 to 25 hours a month. If we utilize this time in a planned manner, this can contribute to our own growth and professional development. The time can be utilized for-

- Reading relevant material/books.
- Making charts and learning tools for children.
- Arranging our own files and papers.
- Cleaning our drawers.
- Planning next day's activities
